### **Committees**

#### **Building Codes & Regulations Committee (BCRC)**

Dedicated to advancing the understanding of building codes, regulations and the public laws governing the building industry. The BCRC hosts 2-4 continuing educational seminars annually.

#### **Building Tours**

Architectural and construction tours that educate the design community and members of the public on historic and new projects. There are 2-5 building tours every year.

#### **Committee on the Environment (COTE)**

Works to advance, disseminate, and advocate design practices that integrate built and natural systems and enhance both the design quality and environmental performance of the built environment. COTE is most known for hosting the Annual Garden Party.

#### Computational Design Detroit (co.de.D)

Empowers students and professionals in the AEC industry to learn, share and implement new ways of thinking that are native to the digital age. They host 4 events annually and manage the Computational Design Award.

#### **Detroit Area BIM User Group (DABUG)**

Educates how technology has changed the building process, specifically within the architectural practice and hosts quarterly events annually.

#### **Emerging Professionals Committee (EPC)**

Empowers the next generation of architects and their collaborators in Metro Detroit. The EPC also hosts an ongoing Architect Registration Examination study group.

#### Women in Architecture (WIA)

Empowering women in the Detroit AEC industry by fostering an inclusive community that provides mentorship, career development, and leadership opportunities, with the goal of creating a more equitable and diverse profession. The WIA hosts 3-5 events a year, including socials. All are welcome!

## **Architectural Honor Awards On-Stage Awards Ceremony**

At the largest annual gathering of AEC professionals in Michigan, we showcase our Chapter awards and how Design can be a driver for sustainable and equitable development around the world. Please note, this is for the on-stage Awards Ceremony, **not** the Celebration of Architecture party.

## Christopher Kelley Leadership Development Program (CKLDP)

The curriculum focuses on core skills such as entrepreneurship and firm management, the art of negotiation, bringing in new clients, community leadership, industry culture, and developing one's future within the practice.

Having hosted CKLDP since 2017, AIA Detroit has graduated 103 scholars, from various building-related professions, to further their careers with the leadership knowledge gained in the program.

#### **COMMONS Lecture Series**

An interactive knowledge series that provides opportunities for individuals to gather and inspire, provoke imagination and thought leadership in the architectural and design community. There are 2-4 COMMONS events every year.
